Purpose

The purpose of the Theatre Arts Teacher is to instill the passions of theatre into our students through a Christian lens that champions each student's creative spirit.

Summary

The Theatre Arts teacher will be responsible for teaching both our Junior High and High School Theatre arts classes, as well as directing their productions. Each class will have one production in the Fall, and one production in the Spring. For our High School class, their Fall production will be a One Act Play that will be used for competition. This position will partner with the Director of Student Development in the leadership and further improving of our Theatre program.

Work Schedule

This is a part-time position starting in August, 2018. The meeting times of the class will be as follows:

- Junior High Theatre: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 1:30 to 2:30
- High School Theatre: Tuesday and Thursday from 2:00 to 3:30

The Theatre Arts teacher will be expected to be available for *minimal* times outside of the class room for events such as Tech and Dress Rehearsal, set-building days, and the productions. There are only a few after-school rehearsals in our model, since we use our class times as our rehearsal times. This stems from our classical model and emphasis on hands on learning.

If you are interested in this position, but can only teach one section due to scheduling, this is still a possibility that we can work out.
